### COX CONFIDENT IN FIRST MISSION AHEAD OF SATURDAY'S STEPHEN FOSTER

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Wednesday, June 26, 2024) – Godolphin's First Mission, the 6-5 morning line favorite for the \$1 million Stephen Foster (Grade I) at Churchill Downs, continues to finalize his preparations ahead of Saturday's marquee race beneath the Twin Spires while trainer, **Brad Cox**, remains confident in the colt's bid for his first Grade I victory.

"We've had this race on our schedule for a long time now," Cox said. "The plan has been if he ran well in the Alysheba to run him in the Stephen Foster. He came out of the Alysheba very well and has been training great at Churchill. The Stephen Foster is always a tough race year in and year out. It's a Grade I, so that's expected. This year's field is no different but we like our chances to try and get him his first Grade I win."

First Mission, a talented 4-year-old son of Street Sense, cruised to a four-length win eight weeks ago in the Alysheba Stakes presented by TwinSpires (GII). Overall, First Mission has won five starts with other graded stakes scores in the Lexington Stakes (GIII) at Keeneland and Essex Handicap (GIII) at Oaklawn Park. First Mission will be ridden in the Stephen Foster by **Florent Geroux** out of post No. 2.

"Florent has been aboard him his last two starts and has been working him in the mornings," Cox said. "They get along very well and Florent knows how to ride him."

Run at 1 1/8 miles, the Stephen Foster is the marquee race of the Churchill Downs Spring Meet following Kentucky Derby Week. The Stephen Foster also is part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge Series and is a "Win and You're In Classic Division" race. The winner will earn a spot in the starting gate for the Nov. 2 Breeders' Cup Classic (GI) at Del Mar with a free automatic entry to the race.

Carded as Race 11 of 12, the Stephen Foster is the highlight of a stakes-filled program at Churchill Downs that also includes the \$500,000 Fasig-Tipton Fleur de Lis (GII); \$500,000 Wise Dan (GII); \$250,000 American Derby (Listed); \$250,000 Kelly's Landing (Listed); and \$250,000 Tepin (Listed). First post is 12:45 p.m. (all times Eastern) and the field for the Stephen Foster will go to post at 6:03 p.m.

**PYRENEES RIDES FOUR-RACE WIN STREAK INTO STEPHEN FOSTER – Blue Heaven Farm**'s 4-year-old colt **Pyrenees** will attempt to win his fifth-consecutive race when he takes on nine rivals in Saturday's \$1 million Stephen Foster (Grade I) at Churchill Downs.

Trained by **Cherie DeVaux**, Pyrenees enters the Stephen Foster after a game three-quarters of a length victory over **Kingsbarns** in the May 17 Pimlico Special (GIII).

"He's a very nice colt who is clearly starting to figure things out," DeVaux said. "He's passed every test given to him so far and the Stephen Foster is another test stepping up to a Grade I. He had a setback and the end of his 2-year-old year and when he came back this winter at Fair Grounds you could tell he mentally and physically matured."

Listed at 12-1 on the morning line odds, Pyrenees will break from the rail under jockey Brian Hernandez Jr.

DOWN THE STRETCH - Live racing at Churchill Downs resumed Wednesday for the start of closing week of the 2024 Spring Meet. First post was 12:45 p.m. for the nine-race card that featured a massive \$275,082 carryover in the 20-cent Derby City 6 Jackpot in the final six races. ... Racing on the Matt Winn Turf Course is scheduled to take place Thursday and Friday in Lane 3, 24 ft. from the inside rail. Saturday and Sunday's turf races are slated to take place in Lane 1. ... Mandatory payouts in all wagers will be Sunday at Churchill Downs. The phenomenal 11-race program will have a first post of 12:45 p.m. and feature the \$300,000 Hanshin (Listed) along with the \$225,000 Bashford Manor (Listed); \$225,000 Debutante (Listed); \$175,000 Anchorage Overnight Stakes; and \$175,000 Maxfield Overnight Stakes. ... The Spring Meet finale of "Inside Churchill Downs" will air Friday at 6 p.m. on ESPN Louisville and preview Saturday and Sunday's 11 stakes events. Join Churchill Downs' Darren Rogers and Kevin Kerstein as they preview the weekend action with the voice of Ellis Park and Turfway Park Tony Calo. Listeners in the Louisville area can tune in live on ESPN 680/105.7 and those worldwide can stream the show on www.espnlouisville.com. Following Friday's show, Rogers and Kerstein will have a 60-day freshening at the farm before returning for the September Meet. Beginning July 12, fans are invited to listen to the "Ky Racing Spotlight with Louie Rabaut presented by the Kentucky HBPA" which will air during the same timeslot throughout the summer. ... The Churchill Downs backstretch is scheduled to be at capacity this summer and house more than 1,400 horses. Several trainers who were based at Churchill Downs' Trackside Louisville are beginning to move over to the main track while the training facility undergoes scheduled maintenance. Among the new faces on the main track will be Bobby Barnett, Jason Cook, Grant Forster, Billy Gowan, Barry King, Michael Puhich, Denis Roberson, Marty Rouck, Brent Taylor, Mike Thompson, Brian Williamson, Freddie Winston and Nick Zito. ...
