POOL FOR MANDATORY PAYOUT OF SUNDAY'S DERBY CITY 6 ON CLOSING DAY SHOULD EASILY ECLIPSE \$1 MILLION

Force-Out of 20-cent Derby City 6 with \$357,208 Carryover on Races 6-11 Starting at 3:18 p.m.

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Saturday, June 29, 2023) – Bettors have a lucrative \$357,208 carryover in the Derby City 6 to chase Sunday at Churchill Downs for the 11-race closing day program.

There is a mandatory payout in Sunday's 20-cent Derby City 6, which covers Races 6-11 starting at approximately 3:18 p.m. (all times Eastern) because it's closing day of the Spring Meet.

The jackpot was \$357,207.76 at the conclusion of Saturday's action.

All monies will be distributed Sunday to ticket holders with the most winners in the six-race series. Track officials estimate the force-out of Sunday's total Derby City 6 pool to easily eclipse \$1 million with new money.

Takeout on the Derby City 6 is just 15% – one of the lowest multi-race wager takeout rates in American racing – and only costs 20 cents per combination.

Sunday's closing day sequence features 63 entered horses for an average of 10.5 entries per race:

- Race 6 (3:18 p.m.): \$175,000 Maxfield Overnight Stakes (Listed), 3yo, 7 F (seven entries)
- Race 7 (3:51 p.m.): \$127,000 OC 100000n1x, 3yo, 1 1/8 M (11 entries)
- Race 8 (4:23 p.m.): \$175,000 Anchorage Overnight Stakes, f&m, 1 1/8 M (T) (nine entries)
- Race 9 (4:55 p.m.): \$225,000 Bashford Manor (Listed), 2yo, 6 F (13 entries)
- Race 10 (5:27 p.m.): \$300,000 Hanshin (Listed), 4&up, 1 M (11 entries)
- Race 11 (5:58 p.m.): Mdn 120k, 3&up, 1 M (T) (16 entries, 12 can run)

Churchill Downs' admission gates will open at 11:30 a.m. The first of 11 races is 12:45 p.m. and the finale is scheduled for 5:58 p.m.
